COVID Cases

COVID cases are continuing to rise in the area surrounding Harewood and in Leeds generally. The threat of having to close class bubbles is very real at the moment, possibly more so now than at any time during the year. You will have heard in the media this week about how the education of the nation's children is still being disrupted by COVID and several of our local schools have had to close bubbles in the last week.
