Please bring the “buns” -sorry I’m from Cambridgeshire and they are fairy cakes to me!!- on the Monday BEFORE the Thursday and drop them off at the art room or library.

THE SALE

Every pupil can purchase up to 2 buns each and the cost is 50p each (£1 in total). The Bun Sale is usually outside and will be between 3pm and 3.15pm. Children choose their own buns & children with allergies are guided by their teachers. Please note, due to COVID restrictions, only exact money can be accepted and NO CHANGE WILL BE GIVEN. Please give your child £1 or 50p.

After the pupil sale, parents/carers and siblings are welcome (even encouraged!!) to buy any left over buns.
