



Children In Need

The theme for this year's Children In Need has been decided by the children in conjunction with their school council representatives.

The theme will be a **swap day** whereby the **children will be the 'teachers'** and the **teachers will be 'pupils' for some of the day.**

- **Pupils can pay £1** to come **dressed as a teacher** e.g. they could bring in their water in a thermos coffee cup rather than a water bottle, wear a homemade lanyard and/or teacher type clothes. I'm told that teachers wear a lot of cardigans! Staff will try and wear something that looks a little bit like a school uniform.
- Pupils will prepare a fact or skill that will take no more than 2mins to present for a takeover lesson. The teacher will sit in the pupil's seat whilst learning this new fact/skill.
- There will be a lucky dip of names to decide which pupils can carry out some other teacher duties like taking the register.
- At break time the hall will be set up as a 'staffroom'. Children can come in and have a biscuit and mark a piece of work that a teacher has completed (for authenticity.)
- There will be four prizes per class for the best fact and best teacher outfit worn by a pupil. One two be decided by the teacher and the other decided by the pupils.
- School Council would also like to carry out a **guess the name of the teddy competition** and they will bring a sign-up sheet around throughout the day. It will be **50p to enter** the guess the name of the teddy.
