Scholastic Book Fair

Starting on **Monday 14th until Thursday 17th February**, we will be holding a book fair event in school. This will take the form of an after-school bookshop in the school hall starting at 3.15pm each day. There will be a range of books for sale which will be suitable for children from Reception to Year 6. There will be **over 200 titles** for you and your child to choose from, and with prices starting from **£2.99**, there's sure to be a book for everyone. In addition to this, you will be able to use your World Book Day £1 book voucher towards any purchase that you make. Your child will be given their book token in school on Friday.

During the event the classes will have chance to look at the books in the school day and hopefully parents and carers will be able to visit the fair after school to select and purchase books for their children. The commission from any book sales from the fair is given to school. This means that the children will be able to select books to restock the classroom book areas and the school library.

As you know, we are running a competition for the children prior to the book fair arriving. The prizes for the competition winners are vouchers to purchase books from the fair. The entries should be handed in on the design sheet, which was given out on Friday last week, no later than **Thursday 10th February** to give time for winners to be chosen and their prizes presented prior to the fair.
