Next week we will be sending out a letter outlining the dates and times for the November parents evenings. Please look out for this.

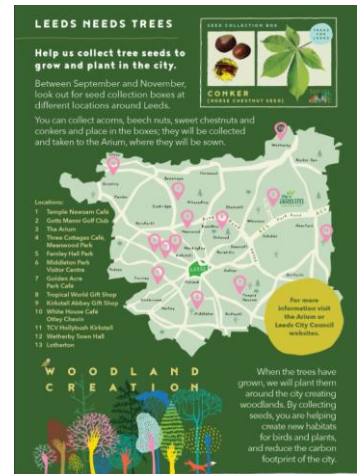


## Eco-News

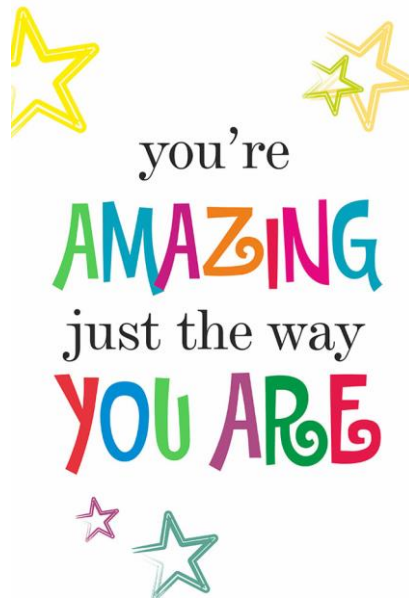

You will need the school code and then the individual artwork code which are at the top of the



form. When ordering please ensure you put the correct class number for your child as this helps track the order. For example, Year 4 is actually Class 3, Reception is Class 1 etc.

Then all you need to do is **ensure that the artwork is returned to school by no later than 9am on Tuesday October 11th** as there is a courier coming to collect the order.
