This week you will have heard in the news about industrial action by members of the National Education Union (NEU). It is a shame for everyone that union members felt strongly enough about the current funding situation in schools and the lack of support for schools from the Government, that it has arrived at this point.

Teaching unions are not just protesting about the levels of teacher pay, but that schools are not being funded for pay increases. This means that any pay rise for staff has to come from existing school budgets. Added to the ever-increasing costs of fuel and general teaching resources this could potentially put the school and many others in a financially unsustainable position.

The dates planned for NEU industrial action are Wednesday 1st February, Tuesday 28th February, Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th March. At present, I am unable to let you know how this will affect our school. Head teachers and Governing Bodies are expected to take all reasonable steps to keep schools open for as many pupils as possible.

We will assess the likely impact of the strike in order to maintain appropriate staffing levels in school and will keep families informed as the picture becomes clearer.






'Wellbeing Statement of the Month'
