SATs

This week saw the release of our Year 6 SATs results. The Year 6 children should be very proud of the work they have put in over the years to achieve the results they have. Whilst we do not currently have any national comparisons, based on last year's national data our year 6 children have achieved significantly higher than those at most schools in the country. This positive picture is also seen in Harewood's results in Year 1 Phonics Screening, KS1 SATs and Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check.

These positive results are a result of years of input by Harewood staff and hard work by the children and are not easy to attain, so as a school we should really celebrate these achievements and the position it places our children in their ability to enter the next phases of education.

End of Year Concert

Thank you to all the families who joined us for our end of year concert yesterday afternoon. I am sure you will agree with me that the children preformed brilliantly, especially those who were new to lessons this year. This was a fabulous opportunity for them to perform for an audience and show off the hard work that they have put in during the year.
