Collective Worship Music - I Vow to Thee My Country

'I Vow to Thee, My Country' is a popular British hymn, created in 1918 when a poem by Sir Cecil Rice was set to music by Gustav Holst, a British composer. The poem is set to an extended version of 'Jupiter' from Holst's Planets Suite.

First performed in 1921, it is strongly associated with Remembrance Day, being performed at services across the UK and the rest of the Commonwealth. It has been used at various state and other high-profile funerals.

Remembrance Day honours those who have served or currently serve to defend our country. We unite across faiths, cultures and backgrounds to remember their sacrifices and also those of their families. The red poppy is a sign of both Remembrance and hope for a peaceful future.
