To purchase tickets, families need to log onto Schoolmoney and go to the shop, where you can choose the number of tickets you would like to buy. There are two options – one for child tickets and one for adult tickets set at £5.00 and £10.00. There is no limit to the number of tickets that can be bought. Please note that tickets will go off sale at 10am on Monday 5th February 2024.
