How lovely to see the children back in school, rested, calm and ready to learn.

We've had a great week in Class 4. On Tuesday, we welcomed Eli who joined our year 6 children and is quickly settling in, making new friends, and learning our routines.

In Class, we started the week by sharing our memories from our summer holiday. We talked about our Behaviour and Anti-Bullying policies and the children designed anti-bullying posters.

We started reading *Who Let the Gods Out* and completed the comprehension activities for the first chapter. Thank you for providing your child with a copy of the text, the rest of the copies will be delivered next week by Leeds City Library.

We've completed the first Maths lesson on Roman Numerals which is the topic of the weekly homework.

We've also started learning about Ancient Greece and analysed the question "Who were the Ancient Greeks?". Class 4 children love learning about the Greeks and it's such a pleasure to see how much work they're already completing in their own time.

Reading in Class 4

Class 4 children have all got a book to read. They're allowed to read books from home as long as they continue to record what they read in their reading records. It is essential that the children read every day, in school and at home. They also should read to an adult at home at least 3 times per week.

Weekly Homework

Today, Class 4 children have received their weekly homework. In Maths, they'll consolidate their knowledge of Roman Numerals. In English, they've received the first set of spellings about "Silent Letters". They've also received 9 statutory spellings to practise during Autumn 1. Every Friday, they'll be tested on the spellings learned during the week.
