Here is the Class update for the last two weeks.

Phonics

We have been learning about the phonemes 'ay' and 'oy.' Year 2 have been learning how to spell words with the 'y' spelling of the igh sound and the 'dge' & 'ge' spelling of the 'j' sound.

English

We have been reading the stories The Colour Monster and Supertato and we have loved them both! We have answered questions about the books and completed writing tasks based on these texts.

Maths

We have been exploring 1 more and 1 less and we have been learning about representing numbers in a variety of ways including writing numerals as words, using 10 frames and base 10.

Other

In ICT we have been using the Espresso Coding package to improve our coding skills. In history we have been learning about Florence Nightingale. Our art work has been based on our texts including making some scary colour monsters and some awesome 3D SuperVeggies. PE has focused on relay races and ball skills. Mrs Watts has been teaching about the senses in Science. Mrs Reynolds and Mrs Jarvis have begun learning the songs and lines for the winter production of Aladdin.

Homework

I have sent home paper copies of the maths and spelling homework for the week. Tests are Monday for Year 1 and Wednesday for Year 2.
