Phonics

<u>Maths</u>

This week we have been working on counting and understanding numbers. Year 1 have focused on different ways of representing numbers to ten and they helped a very silly alien to learn how to count. Year 2 have been working on numbers to 100 including place value and counting in 10s.

Other Subjects

In PE, we practiced different playground games. In art, we made birthday cards for the birthday box. PSHE this week was letting Mrs Miller know all about us. In RE, we learnt about what God means to us and what the Holy trinity represents to Christians.
