Dear Parents,

Thank you for your generous donations to our harvest celebration. I hope you enjoyed our performance today. I tried to video the rehearsal to put on Tapestry but it didn't turn out well. The children did amazingly this afternoon. I was so proud of their lovely clear speaking voices, joyous singing and brilliant actions including Makaton for the In My Trolley song. It was fab, they all shone and I hope you were entertained!

Here is the Class update for the last two weeks.

Phonics

We have been learning about the phonemes 'ie' as in tie and 'ea' as in leaf. Year 2 have been learning how to spell plurals and verbs that require the 'y' to change to an 'i' before adding es or ed and words spelt with the silent 'g' as in gnome.

English

We have been reading the stories The Shopping Basket by John Burningham and Sea Park. The children really enjoyed the shopping basket story as some silly animals that tried to steal Steven's shopping got their just desserts.

Maths

We have been exploring estimating, ordering and comparing numbers including using the > < = signs correctly to compare numbers and amounts.

Other

We have been using timelines and comparing hospitals in the past to now in history. In art we mixed paints to complete colour wheels and made pastel pictures of bowls of fruit. In PE we have been improving our throwing and catching skills. ICT has focused on coding click and key events. Music and drama lessons are now spent practising for the big winter production of Aladdin.

Homework

I have sent home paper copies of the maths and spelling homework for the week. Tests are Monday for Year 1 and Wednesday for Year 2.
