Welcome back! It was lovely to see you all on Wednesday and Thursday evening. Thank you for taking the time to see me after school.

Firstly, well done to Class 4 children who took part in the WVLP football tournament. They displayed an excellent example of sportsmanship and had a great time!

Thank you to Dave from D: Side who led a useful and fun lesson on Internet safety. Children were encouraged to reflect on how to use social media safely and age-appropriate content to watch online. He encouraged the children to work as a team with parents and grown-ups making sure children tell parents what social media they use and how they use them.

In Class 4, we started a new English topic. Children will write the Ultimate Guide to Unicorns. Inspired by Pie Corbett, we are examining texts about unicorns and researching new types of unknown unicorns we may be talking about. This week, we learnt about unicorns' location and appearance.

In Maths, we learned about the rules of divisibility and prime and square numbers.

Class 4 completed their post-topic assessment in Science and learnt about Adaptation and Inheritance, part of our new topic called Evolution and Inheritance. In RE, we started learning scientific theories about creation and how they clash with Christian beliefs.
