

Good afternoon,

I hope this email finds you well.

We have had a busy week this week with Lenten celebrations, a trip to Harewood Estate and also World Book Day.

Thank you so much for arranging such fabulous costumes for the children, they all looked amazing. There were also some fantastic front cover designs and generous donations to the book swap.

This week we have been learning about using grouping and arrays to support multiplication and division in our maths lessons with Miss Ali.

We have continued looking at The Legend of Finn McCool in English and the children described some of their own fearsome giants.

In phonics the children began learning about soft c and soft g. Year 2 have begun about doubling consonants before adding the suffixes -ing/-ed in CVC and CCVC words.

In geography we learnt about aerial views, in science we planted seeds, in art we looked at the work of Van Gogh and recreated The Starry Night in pastel and in PE we performed a dance to the four seasons and began learning about travelling and passing. We also learnt about Ramadan in our RE lessons and drew some comparisons to Lent.

The children should have a paper maths worksheet on the two times tables and some new spellings in their folders.
