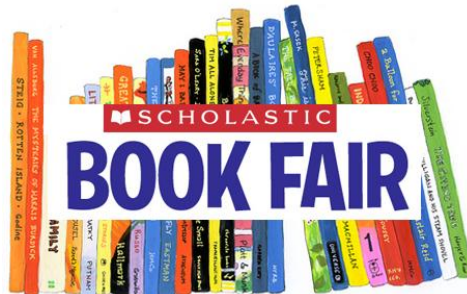

Dear Families,

We are very pleased to announce that the Scholastic Book Fair will be in school from **Tuesday 24th to Friday 27th February.**

The Book Fair is a book shop, where families can browse and purchase books for their children. It will be open **in the hall at the end of the school day to approximately 3.50pm**, depending on how long people stay. School is usually cashless, but for the fair, it is simpler and quicker for us to do **cash sales only**. Please remember to bring cash for the events and if you have change, that really helps us.

There is always a good range of interesting books for all primary school ages with both fiction and non-fiction titles available. As well as being a wonderful opportunity to purchase books and foster a love of reading, school receives up to 50% commission on all sales. We can then use this commission to purchase additional reading and learning resources to add to our classroom resources. In previous years we have been able to purchase class sets of dictionaries, thesaurus, class texts, as well as supplementing books for topics and classroom individual readers.

Before the Book Fair arrives in school, we are running a competition to give everyone the chance to win book tokens that can be redeemed against books of their choice at the book fair.

Details of the competitions have been sent out by individual classes, but Class 1 are doing an imaginary picture competition titled 'This is not a fish. It is a...'. and classes 2, 3 and 4 are holding a 500 word story writing competition. All entries must be handed in to class teachers by 9am on Monday 23rd February so classes can choose winners and prizes be awarded before the fair begins.

There will be 2 voucher prizes for each class for the winners to spend at the fair, so thinking caps on over the holiday and good luck.
